

A career as a 9-1-1 Public Safety Telecommunicator is a rewarding and challenging way to serve the citizens of Utah and Juab Counties




Public Safety Telecommunicators operate communications equipment, answer emergency and non-emergency calls from the general public and dispatch the appropriate police, fire and EMS units.
