



CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

ENTRANCE OF AMERICAN FORK CANYON TO TIBBLE FORK AND PINE HOLLOW

In a joint effort among the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), the U.S. Forest Service, the National Park Service, and Crown Castle International, crews will be installing conduit, fiber and cell poles along S.R. 92 and S.R. 144 to improve communications and to enhance safety in American Fork Canyon. **Starting Monday, Sept. 30, crews will begin phase one of construction working from Tibble Fork Reservoir and Pine Hollow Trailhead back toward the mouth of the canyon.** Phase one, conduit installation, is expected to last through **early November.**

What to Expect:

- Crews working Sunday nights - Friday afternoons (there will be no work on the weekends)
- Lane restrictions and one-way traffic with flaggers. All traffic is required to stop including bikes
- Travel delays
- Large construction vehicles entering/exiting the work zone



Construction schedules are weather-dependent and subject to change
