

Alpine Youth Council Application Requirements

Thank you for your interest in serving on the Alpine Youth Council. If you are selected, this program will provide you with many opportunities for leadership, community involvement, and service. Part of the application process includes you completing the requirements and activities listed below. Failure to complete any of these requirements will likely keep you from being accepted on the council.

- Complete AYC Application and submit via email to alpineut@gmail.com **no later than April 10, 2019.**
- Obtain one Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, employer, church leader, etc. Please have the individual who writes the letter email it to alpineut@gmail.com no later than April 10, 2019.
- Attend one AYC meeting either March 28 or April 11 at 8 p.m. at City Hall. You must sign in to get credit for attending.
- Everyone who completes the above-mentioned requirements will have a personal interview with AYC leaders on April 18 at City Hall. Please come dressed appropriately for an interview. If your last name begins with A-K, come between 7:00-8:00 pm. If your last name begins with L-Z, come between 8:00-9:00 pm.

Upon completion of the interviews, we will select our new Alpine Youth Council and notify all applicants either through emails or through the US Mail. You will be notified in that letter of the date for our first meeting. The new Alpine Youth Council will serve from July 2019 to May 2020.

Please be aware that, due to the number of applications we receive each year far in excess of the number of positions available on AYC, each individual will be limited to two terms (two years) of service. Some Sophomores (as of fall 2019) will be selected; however, priority is generally given to Juniors and Seniors.

Selected candidates must be willing to do the following:

1. Attend at least 75% of all youth council meetings and service activities throughout the year.
2. Purchase a t-shirt and polo to be worn throughout the year (cost approximately \$35) and pay an activity fee of \$25.
3. Set a proper example to the community at all times.
4. Actively participate in all meetings and activities. We meet the 1st and 3rd Thursday of every month at 8 p.m. We usually have one service activity per month. You **must** be able to participate in Alpine Days activities (held the week of August 3-10). Let your parents know this so they can plan family vacations accordingly. This is our biggest service project of the year!
