RESOLUTION #RES. 2014.05

Adopted February 13, 2014

A RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS SUPPORT FOR LEGISLATION THAT WOULD ALLOW COUNTIES, CITIES, AND TOWNS TO LEVY A THREE PERCENT LOCAL OPTION USER FEE ON GASOLINE.

WHEREAS, under current taxes, there is a projected \$11.3 billion shortfall over the next thirty years for roadway projects in Utah.

WHEREAS, county and city roadways will account for approximately \$3 to \$4 billion of the projected shortfall.

WHEREAS, the costs of maintaining roadways are significantly less than the costs of rehabilitating roadways or reconstructing roadways.

WHEREAS, a local option user fee on the sale of gasoline within the State of Utah would, if enacted, generate approximately \$3 to \$4 billion for roadways in counties, cities, and towns.

WHEREAS, the Toquerville City Council and Mayor believe that funds generated by a local option user fee on gasoline would be best utilized if allocated by local governments.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Toquerville City Council and Mayor support legislation to be undertaken by the Utah State Legislature that would allow counties, cities, or towns to adopt a 3 percent local option user fee on fuel but only if not more than 50 percent the revenues generated in Washington County via the fee would go to the City in the form of Class B and Class C Roads Account Payments (see Utah Code § 72-2-107) and not less than 50 percent of the revenue generated in Washington County via the fee would flow to Washington County and be distributed within Washington County by the Washington County Council of Government.


