

**TOQUERVILLE CITY  
RESOLUTION #RES.2016.12**

**A RESOLUTION CREATING A POLICY DISALLOWING RENTAL OF THE CITY PARKS AND THE CITY HALL ON HOLIDAYS**

WHEREAS, city parks belong to all residents of Toquerville; and

WHEREAS, city park rental denies access to all residents who might otherwise enjoy holiday use; and

WHEREAS, city employees are responsible to maintain city parks and city buildings; and

WHEREAS, employees are given holidays as time off to spend with family.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Toquerville City Council shall adopt the following policy regarding City Park and City Hall Rentals:

No rental shall be made or allowed to be made of any City parks or buildings on the following holidays:

New Year's Day – January 1st;

President's Day – 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in February;

Memorial Day – Last Monday in May;

Independence Day – July 4<sup>th</sup>;

Pioneer Day – July 24<sup>th</sup>;

Labor Day – 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in September;

Thanksgiving Eve, Thanksgiving Day & the day after Thanksgiving Day – 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday in November, the Wednesday before, and the Friday following.

Christmas Eve – December 24<sup>th</sup>;

Christmas Day – December 25<sup>th</sup>;

New Year's Eve – December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Should the noted holiday fall on a Monday or a Friday, the Saturday and Sunday that are immediately following or preceding the Monday or Friday in succession shall be included in the no-rental policy.
