Resolution #RES.2007-10, August 9th, 2007

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION, AFTER PROPER NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH UCA 59-2-919, FOR PROPOSED INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAX LEVY OF THE CITY OF TOQUERVILLE, INCREASING THE NEW CERTIFIED TAX RATE TO .000845 AND FORWARDING TO WASHINGTON COUNTY AUDITOR AND TAX COMMISSION BY AUGUST 17TH, 2007 AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH UCA 59-2-913 AND 29-2-920.

WHEREAS, the City Council, after review and consideration, has determined the need for increased property tax revenue to support and provide for services and expenditures in administration of Toquerville City Government; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has also determined the increased revenue needed is approximately \$40,000 over last year's budgeted revenue of \$38,102, in order to meet new Budget requirements; and

WHEREAS, this proposed increase will bring the new City tax revenue to \$81,000 and raise a \$200,000 County assessed residence from \$46.97 to \$92.95 per year;

THEREFORE, the Toquerville City Council resolves that the increase of City Certified Tax Rate will be initiated on all properties in the Municipal boundaries not otherwise exempted by law, shall be taxed the new Certified Tax Rate of .000845;

ADOPTED this 9th day of August, 2007; Resolution (RES.2007.10) shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Toquerville City Council, forwarded to the Washington County Auditor and Tax Commission, Form PT-800, by August 17th, 2007.
