

# RESOLUTION #RES.2010.04, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2010

## **TOQUERVILLE CITY – Culinary Water Standby Fee, Non-User ADMINISTRATIVE & PUBLIC WORKS SCHEDULE**

Amending and Replacing Resolution #RES.2009.04-A (8-13-09).

**PURPOSE:** This Resolution will amend the Public Works Fees Schedule for the purpose of providing a “Non-User”, Culinary Water Standby Monthly Fee - \$5.00; with no meter on property and approved Application.

**NOTE:**

This Resolution will not repeal, abrogate, annul, impair, or interfere with existing provisions of other resolutions, ordinances, or laws, except to effect modification of the fees listed. The fees listed in this approved Schedule supersede present fees for the services specified, but all fees not listed remain in effect. Where this Resolution imposes a higher fee than is imposed or required by existing provisions of prior resolutions, the provisions of this Resolution shall control.
