A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE
TOQUERVILLE CITY COMMUNITY PARKS MASTER PLAN 2016

WHEREAS, Toquerville City as a community recognizes that park facilities enhance the quality of life experience by community residents; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville residents and developers have worked together to make parks available throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City collects impact fees for parks and trails; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City receives Recreation, Arts, and Park tax revenues from Washington County; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City has experienced steady growth requiring planning of the park areas that have been set aside for future development; and

WHEREAS, the City understands the importance of developing a comprehensive master plan for a community-wide park system that satisfies the current and future recreation needs of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted with Jackson Land Design, working with the parks committee and City Council to create a comprehensive master plan for all current park areas within the city; and

WHEREAS, this Plan is intended to be a working document to be reviewed regularly as improvements are installed in the parks by those appointed by the Mayor and/or when the City Council sees the need of updating to reflect necessary modifications.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Toquerville City Council shall adopt the Toquerville City Community Parks Master Plan 2016.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage of this Resolution by the Toquerville City Council.
