A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2017-2021

WHEREAS the City of Toquerville recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Toquerville; and

WHEREAS the City of Toquerville has participated in the creation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereinafter known as the Five County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017-2021, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the Five County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017-2021 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Toquerville from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Toquerville City Council demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Five County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017-2021.
