

A RESOLUTION INDICATING THE INTENT OF TOQUERVILLE CITY, UTAH
TO ADJUST ITS COMMON BOUNDRY WITH THE
CITY OF LA VERKIN, UTAH

WHEREAS, Utah law, as found in Utah Code Ann. Sec 10-2-419(2)(a)(i) indicates that a municipality intending to adjust its common boundary with a neighboring municipality must adopt a resolution indicating such intent: and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City intends to adjust its common boundary with the City of LaVerkin such that the property described below will be adjusted from Toquerville City into the City of LaVerkin:


BEGINNING at the Southeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 41 South Range 13 West Salt Lake Base and Meridian; and running thence North 0 degrees 15'33" East along the East Line of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 976.00 feet to the thread of LaVerkin Creek; thence South 26 degrees 55'46" West 531.17 feet; thence South 24 degrees 49'12" West 547.00 feet to the South line of said Section 14; thence South 89 degrees 16'09" East 465.81 more or less to the Point of Beginning.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Toquerville City Council that Toquerville City hereby declares its intent to adjust a common boundary it has with the City of LaVerkin such that the property described in the above description will be adjusted from Toquerville City into the City of LaVerkin.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
