

A RESOLUTION THAT ALLOWS TOQUERVILLE CITY TO APPLY FOR STATE EMERGENCY FUNDING
FROM WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH

WHEREAS, Toquerville City is a sub-division of Washington County, and

WHEREAS, sub-divisions are permitted by HB 240 to apply for public assistance due to the local flooding emergency in January 2005, and


WHEREAS, Toquerville City does not have sufficient funds to make repairs on its infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City by Resolution 02-22-05 is requesting a loan for damages suffered in the amount of \$40,000 (Forty thousand) with the price including heavy equipment rental for the repairs needed to on the followings projects:

- 1) Center Street Wash-out consisting of
 - a. Repair sewer and irrigation line repair
 - b. Replacing fill material
 - c. Replace type II road base
 - d. Replace asphalt
- 2) Center Street Bridge repair consisting of:
 - a. Temporarily reroute Ash Creek
 - b. Rip-rap as needed
 - c. Concrete re-enforcement as needed
 - d. Repair asphalt settlement
- 3) City Park Repairs consisting of:
 - a. Parking lot fill, replacement and re-grading
 - b. Replacement of sod and re-grading
 - c. Irrigation systems repairs
 - d. Silt removal
- 4) Old Church Road Bridge Repair consisting of:
 - a. Dig-out and re-compact approaches
 - b. Rip-rap as needed
 - c. Concrete re-enforcement as needed
 - d. Replace asphalt as needed



RESOLUTION NO. 5-13-04 E

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL DISASTER MITIGATION AND COST REDUCTION ACT OF 2000.

WHEREAS, th President signed H.R. 707, the *Disaster Mitigation and Cost Reduction Act of 2000*, into law on October 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all jurisdictions to be covered by a Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan to be eligible for Federal Emergency Management Agency post-disaster funds,

WHEREAS, Five County Association of Governments (FCAOG) has been contracted by the State of Utah to prepare a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan covering all of the jurisdictions in the FCAOG Area, and

WHEREAS, the FCAOG Executive Council approved FCAOG Staff to write the plan, and

WHEREAS, ** is within the FCAOG Area, and

WHEREAS, the ** Council is concerned about mitigating potential losses from natural disasters before they occur, and

WHEREAS, the plan identifies potential hazards, potential loses and potential mitigation measures to limit loses, and


