A RESOLUTION OF TOQUERVILLE CITY CREATING AND APPOINTING A MILITARY COMMUNITY COVENANT LIAISON TO BE APPOINTED FROM THE CITY OF TOQUERVILLE, UTAH AND GIVING THE LIAISON THE ABILITY TO FORM A COMMITTEE AS NEEDED.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Toquerville, Utah, wishes to create a Military Community Covenant Liaison position and giving the Liaison the ability to form a committee as needed to encourage Community Assistance to Military Services Personnel and their Families, and to Honor and Celebrate the Military Services Personnel who have served, or are presently serving in the United States Military.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Toquerville, Utah that Councilman Mark Fahrenkamp, a resident of Toquerville, Utah, shall be, and is hereby, designated to serve as Toquerville Community Covenant Liaison until such time that a successor has been designated and appointed.

THIS RESOLUTION shall repeal and supersede all prior ordinances and resolutions governing the same that are in direct contradiction hereto, and
