



**TOQUERVILLE CITY
RESOLUTION 2017.08
BRINGHURST BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT**

RE-ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE TOQUERVILLE CITY COUNCIL INDICATING THE CITY'S INTENT TO CONSIDER ADJUSTMENT OF A PORTION OF ITS COMMON BOUNDARIES WITH LAVERKIN CITY, UTAH AND AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING WHEREBY THE CITY COUNCIL WILL RECEIVE PUBLIC INPUT AND COMMENT REGARDING THE SAME.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Toquerville City ("Toquerville" or "City"), is a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville shares certain common boundaries with LaVerkin City ("LaVerkin"), a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, an application ("Application") has been submitted by private property owners requesting that that a portion of the common boundaries between LaVerkin and Toquerville be adjusted as shown in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the requested boundary adjustment will result in the removal of certain parcels of real property comprising approximately 0.69 acres from the incorporated area and jurisdictional authority of LaVerkin and the addition of such parcels of property to the incorporated area and jurisdictional authority of Toquerville, as shown in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 requires that the legislative body of each municipality considering an adjustment to a boundary that is common with another municipality to adopt a resolution indicating this consideration; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville and LaVerkin are willing to consider such an adjustment as requested in the Application and as described and illustrated in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the location, topography and natural features of certain parcels along the common boundary with LaVerkin are such that Toquerville may be in a better position to provide municipal services to such parcels.

RESOLUTION

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of Toquerville City, State of Utah, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby declares its intent to consider adjustment of a portion of its common boundary with LaVerkin City, as indicated on Exhibit "A" and more particularly described in the legal description included in Exhibit "A. The public and "Affected Entities" are

notified that City Council may adjust the common boundary as described in the Application unless a protest as provided in Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 is received against the proposed boundary adjustment.

2. Furthermore, The City Council will hold a public hearing on the proposed boundary adjustment on JUNE 8, 2017 at 6:30 am pm at the Toquerville City Council Chambers. City staff is directed to publish notice of such hearing and the proposed boundary adjustment in accordance with Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419. The first publication of notice of the public hearing shall be within fourteen (14) days of the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.

3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval and passage by the City Council.
