



Season begins March 1.

On Sunday, March 1 the Toquerville Secondary Water System (TSWS) will be back on for the 2020 season.



Residential water schedule is from 6 p.m. to 2 a.m. Watering days are assigned by house numbers:

- Even numbered houses--Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
- Odd numbered houses--Monday, Wednesday, and Friday



Agriculture watering times are from 5 a.m. to noon. The watering days for each zone are:

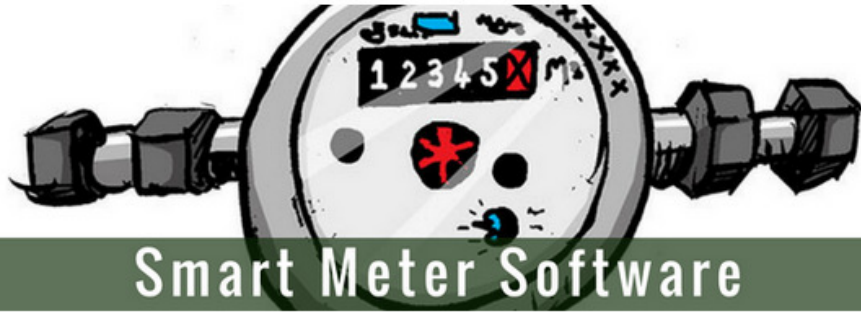
- Zone 1: Monday and Thursday
- Zone 2: Tuesday and Friday
- Zone 3: Wednesday and Saturday

If you're unsure of your zone, please send an email to julie@wcwcd.org. She can let you know what zone you're in.



Home vegetable gardens are allowed to be watered outside the residential watering time of 6 p.m. to 2 a.m., if following these criteria:

- Vegetable gardens must only be irrigated on the assigned watering day for that resident.
 - Even house numbers--Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
 - Odd house numbers--Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
- Vegetable gardens must be watered with a drip system.



Smart Meter Software

As many of you know, meters are now installed on all TSWS connections. If you're interested in accessing your meter information, please send an email to bill@wcwcd.org. She'll send you an email with the steps to set up a user profile to access this information. Access of this information can be made from a smart phone app or web browser. This app provides leak alerts, personal water use comparisons and helps you manage your landscape water needs based on local weather.



Water Waste Penalties

The following TSWS policy, which became effective on April 16, 2007, applies to all water users on the system.

After a water waste complaint has been received and verified, a warning notice will be sent for the first two violations. If a third violation is found valid, a fine of twice the annual assessment for that parcel will be charged. A fourth valid water abuse complaint will result in a fine three times the assessed value. If this continues to a fifth water waste complaint, the water will be shut off for the rest of the season. Violations include, but are not limited to:

- Watering outside of the watering times
- Water running off property
- Excess water forming on property creating temporary ponds.

Appointments are now being taken for a free water check! A Water check includes meeting with a technician which runs a series of tests on your sprinkler system. The results provide system pressure, how evenly water is applied to the lawn area and how fast water is applied. The homeowner is given a recommended irrigation schedule.
