SUPPORT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE HURRICANE VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT

PURPOSE: A Resolution supporting the Washington County Commissioners passing of their Resolution, establishing the Hurricane Valley Fire District.

WHEREAS, the communities of LaVerkin, Toquerville, and Virgin currently contract with the City of Hurricane for Fire Protection, Paramedic Service & Ambulance Service; and

WHEREAS, the growth of Eastern Washington County has stretched the resources of the Hurricane City Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the creation of Special Service District for the purpose of providing said services would afford the following benefits:

- Shared costs equally applied by all those serviced by the District by having an evenly applied property tax rate and balanced impact fee schedule,
- Logical placement of District resources without limitation of municipal boundaries,
- Improved command and control,
- Economies of Scale,
- Uniformity of interchangeable equipment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Toquerville City Council supports the Washington County Commission's adoption of A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HURRICANE VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT.

THIS RESOLUTION shall repeal and supercede all prior ordinances and resolutions governing the same that are in direct contradiction hereto, and

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective immediately upon approval and adoption by Toquerville City Council on the 11th day of November 2010.
