**A RESOLUTION SHOWING COMMITMENT TO FINANCIAL AND LEGAL OBLIGATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH RECEIPT OF WaterSMART GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

WHEREAS, Toquerville City desires to receive a matching grant from the Department of Reclamation for the Hillside Road Project in order to replace historic water lines on Hillside Road and Cotton Gin Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires an official resolution showing support and knowledge of the City's responsibilities upon receiving said grant; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City is capable of providing the amount of funding and/or in-kind contributions specified in the grant funding plan to match the grant as proposed; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City desires to work with the Department of Reclamation to meet established deadlines as required by entering into a cooperative agreement.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Toquerville City Council that

- A. Toquerville City desires to receive a matching grant from the Department of Reclamation for the Hillside Road Project in order to replace historic water lines on Hillside Road and Cotton Gin Avenue; and
- B. the City Council as the governing body of Toquerville City has reviewed and desire to make a show of support for the application to be submitted; and
- C. Toquerville City is capable of providing the amount of funding and/or in-kind contributions specified in the grant funding plan to match the grant as proposed; and
- D. Toquerville City desires to work with the Department of Reclamation to meet established deadlines as required by entering into a cooperative agreement.
