DUTIES:

- Maintain city parks and public facilities
- Operate various types of heavy, light, and complex equipment used in the maintenance of parks, including sweepers, mowers, turf equipment, hand tools, etc.
- Perform light maintenance of all equipment used for safety and efficiency purposes.
- Perform general cleanup of park areas and maintain picnic sites
- Repair and replace irrigation systems
- Prune Trees and maintain flower beds.
- Work in trenches
- Operating snowplow and snow removal during winter months
- Assist with other public works projects as needed including but not limited to addressing water leaks, asphalt maintenance

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Must possess a valid Driver's License. Must possess or be able to acquire a Commercial Driver's License and Commercial Pesticide Applicator's License within 90 days of hire. GIS experience is a plus.

Experience: Tree and shrub pruning, other large-scale plant maintenance. Understand troubleshooting, repair, and maintenance of sprinkler systems and controllers.

Communication Skills: Daily interaction with other employees within the public works department and other departments is expected. Maintain harmonious relations with city employees and the public.

Work Environment: Frequent walking, stooping, crouching, and bending; required pushing, pulling or lifting up to 100 lbs. This position requires heavy physical activity. Extensive field work (90% of work is performed outside); frequent exposure to noise, cold, heat, dust, and wet; constant exposure to excessive noise and vibration. There will be occasional evening and weekend work.
