



Notice of Award Without Competition

MBR Tank Maintenance

Notice is hereby given that the Jordanelle Special Service District (the "District") is awarding a contract for the purchase of maintenance services for the membrane bioreactor ("MBR") tanks at the District's wastewater treatment facility. The services include removing and storing membrane cassettes from the tanks, removing existing liners from the MBR tanks, applying a new liner material, and assisting with the reinstallation of the membrane cassettes in the MBR tanks.

The District is awarding the contract to Utility Service Company, Inc. ("USCI") without going through a standard competitive procurement process because:

- USCI designed and provided the original membrane cassettes and MBR tanks. As such, the current work is a continuation of previous work, and USCI is uniquely familiar with the MBR system and the District's facility.
- USCI is the only company that is willing to store and be responsible for the membrane cassettes while the re-lining work is completed. Other companies could do the re-lining work, but would require the District to store the cassettes at the District's own risk.
