



Notice of Award Without Competition

Power Line Replacement Project

Notice is hereby given that the Jordanelle Special Service District (the "District") is awarding a contract for the purchase of engineering and construction services necessary to provide a new underground power line to the District's Ontario No. 2 mine shaft building (the "Mine Bench"), and to de-energize the District's existing power line that serves the Mine Bench. The services include coordinating with Rocky Mountain Power to connect to its existing underground power line.

The District is awarding the contract to Summit Line Construction ("Summit") without going through a standard competitive procurement process because:

- Summit and its personnel have been working closely with the District for over a year, studying the supply of power to the Mine Bench, and the distribution of power within the Mine Bench facilities, including to the old mine shaft hoist and down the mine shaft. Summit has valuable understanding of the complicated power supply and distribution situation at the Mine Bench. Transitioning to a new contractor at this point would be costly and inefficient.
- The power replacement project needs to be completed as soon as possible. Based on the District's Procurement Policy, it is impractical and inadvisable to award the contract through a standard procurement process.
