PART II - PRODUCT

DESCRIPTION

- PortaFloor MAX is a heavy-duty, easy to install, modular flooring / matting system that is designed for indoor and outdoor use, and is environmentally friendly promoting a zero-footprint. PortaFloor MAX provides a stable, light weight flooring/ matting surface that can be installed by hand or machine and conforms over the sub base surfaces to produce a contiguous safe surface.
- 2. PortaFloor MAX is 100% recyclable.
- 3. PortaFloor MAX100 is made with recycled materials.
- 4 PortaFloor MAXColor available in custom colors.
- 5. PortaFloor MAXSafety is bright yellow for additional visibility on site.
