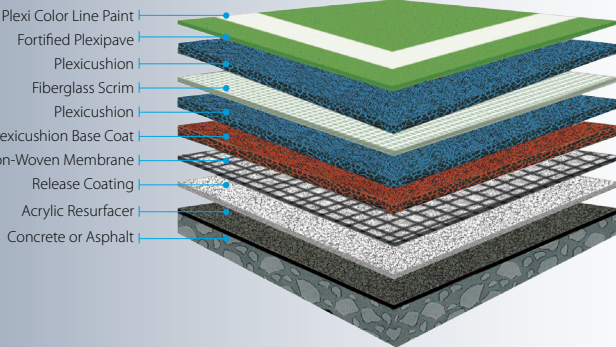
Surface of the Australian Open



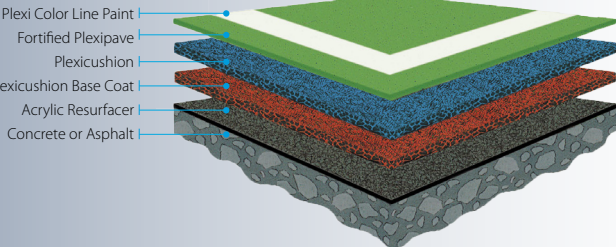

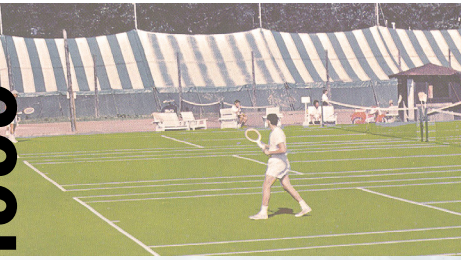

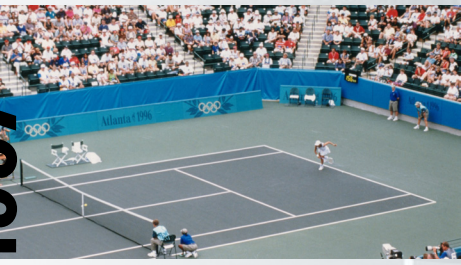
