If you just took a video, it's easy to find it. Here, Video: You're seeing videos from all the different applications that play or record videos. This includes GroupMe, Snapchat and other apps. The YouTube application includes simple trimming features. Drag the blue circles on either side of the blue rectangle to reduce the length of the video. 6 video title. You want to create a title that's relevant to the content of the video. This makes it easier for people to find your videos. Don't hit irrelevant videos to get more views. Not only does this make your audience worse, it can almost guarantee the likes of your videos. 7 Enter it in the description. You don't have to include much in your description, but viewers will know what's going on in your video. For example, if your video is fireworks on July 4th, include where you watched the show. Predict which questions your viewers will have and include answers to their descriptions. 8 Set privacy. Under the Privacy header, you will see three options for privacy options. After you upload your video, you can change your privacy options later. Private: Only you can watch the video. This is a useful option if you want a place where you can save your videos. It's also a great option for testing the look of your videos on YouTube before they're released. Non-list: Only people with links can watch your video. This is a great option if you only want to share your video with specific people, such as friends and family. But that doesn't stop you from sharing links with others. Public: Anyone can view your video by searching for a title or by checking the video in the Featured Videos list. 9 Add a tag. Tags help YouTube decide when to display a video when a user searches for a term. For example, if your video has a League of Legends tag, it's likely to appear when users search for League of Legends videos. Adding tags increases the chances that YouTube will suggest videos to people who are interested in tags. You want to stay relevant to tags and content. If tagging is too free, you may receive spam notifications. Upload 10 videos. If you're an Android user, tap the icon that looks like an arrow pointing to the right.
