

RESOLUTION #RES.2009.05, AUG.13TH, 2009

TOQUERVILLE CITY - Storm Drain Utility Fee ADMINISTRATIVE & PUBLIC WORKS FEE SCHEDULE

Amending and Replacing Resolution 2008-02 (6-12-08)

PURPOSE: This Resolution will amend the Public Works Fees Schedule for the purpose of assisting City Streets Department in accumulating funds dedicated to the City Storm Water System; to repair, maintain, and reconstruct City roads and streets where needed. The Storm Drain Utility Fee is to be imposed on all properties in TOQ City Boundaries based on Equivalent Residential Unit of 5,000 SF (ERU), and Regulations set forth in ORD.2009.07, Storm Water Utility Fee, Land Management Code, Chapter 20 (this RES.2009.05 is referenced as Attachment "A").

NOTE:

This Resolution will not repeal, abrogate, annul, impair, or interfere with existing provisions of other resolutions, ordinances, or laws, except to effect modification of the fees listed. The fees listed in this approved Schedule supersede present fees for the services specified, but all fees not listed remain in effect. Where this Resolution imposes a higher fee than is imposed or required by existing provisions of prior Resolutions, the provisions of this Resolution shall control.
