WHEREAS, The City of Toquerville has determined that mosquitoes are a health hazard that does not recognize City boundaries and the City must provide for the health, safety and welfare of residents of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, The City has determined by jointly providing mosquito abatement services in the established Southwest Mosquito Abatement & Control District (hereafter referred as the District) to correspond to the Washington County boundaries, including the municipalities located in the County, the County will benefit from shared efficiency and costs; and

WHEREAS, The District will be governed by a Board of Trustees consisting of one trustee appointed by each Municipality and one Trustee appointed by the County Commission; and

WHEREAS, The District Board of Trustees will have the powers approved by law, to take all necessary and proper steps for the extermination of mosquitoes, flies, crickets, grasshoppers, and other insects within the district and to abate as nuisances all stagnant pools of water and other breeding places for mosquitoes, flies, crickets, grasshoppers, or other insects;

THEREFORE, the City agrees to allow the District to annually assess the landowner through the Washington County Assessors Office each fiscal year. The average estimated financial impact to each household for year 2007 will be approximately \$2.80 per \$100,000 valuation.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Toquerville City shall agree to the terms set forth in this Resolution and by the District for the purpose of a Countywide Mosquito Abatement Program.
