

RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-13-04 E 2004.05

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL DISASTER MITIGATION AND COST REDUCTION ACT OF 2000.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States signed H.R. 707, the *Disaster Mitigation and Cost Reduction Act of 2000*, into law on October 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all jurisdictions to be covered by a Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan to be eligible for Federal Emergency Management Agency post-disaster funds,

WHEREAS, Five County Association of Governments was contracted by the State of Utah to prepare a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan covering all jurisdictions within the Five County Association of Governments region; and

WHEREAS, the Five County Association of Governments Steering Committee directed the Five County Association of Governments staff to write the Plan; and

WHEREAS, Toquerville City Corporation is a member of the Five County Association of Governments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Toquerville City is concerned about potential natural disasters and desires to prevent or limit losses from natural disasters before they occur; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies likely hazards, potential losses and possible mitigation measures to limit losses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the community as a whole to adopt the Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan as it pertains to the City; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TOQUERVILLE CITY THAT:

the Five County Association of Governments Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is adopted to meet the requirements of the *Disaster Mitigation and Cost Reduction Act of 2000*.


This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
