



**TOQUERVILLE CITY  
ORDINANCE 2018.02 OFFICERS COMPENSATION**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 3, ARTICLE A-1 SETTING MAYOR COMPENSATION AT \$1,000 PER MONTH AND REMOVING COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, wages of \$1,000 were originally established for the Mayor to cover his costs in order to attend meetings and to compensate for time to perform the duties of his office; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the then-city council voted by Resolution 2011.06 to provide a \$500 increase in the Mayor's salary to fulfill the tasks of City Manager in lieu of hiring a city manager; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2011.06 included a Sunset Clause to remove the extra compensation beginning January 1, 2014 for the City Manager tasks that was never updated or removed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in examining the conditions and needs of the City desires to recognize the original Mayor salary of \$1,000 and follow the direction of the 2014 Sunset Clause; removing compensation for City Manager tasks from the Mayor's salary; and

WHEREAS, the regular pay day is prior to the second Thursday of the month.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOQUERVILLE, UTAH THAT TITLE 1, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 3, ARTICLE A-1 SHOULD BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

**Chapter 7 OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES**

**1-7-3: COMPENSATION**

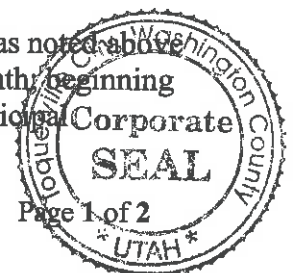
**A. Mayor And Council:**

1. Specified: The monthly compensation for members of the governing body and mayor shall be set by ordinance and reviewed no less than once every three (3) years. The present compensation paid to the mayor and members of the council are as follows:

Mayor    ~~\$500.00~~    **\$1,000.00**

Council members    200 .00

2. Payment: The city treasurer shall pay the mayor and elected or appointed officials as noted above ~~on~~ **prior to** the second Thursday of each month for work performed the previous month beginning in July, 2007. These payments will be made by delivery of a check drawn on the municipal checking account to those persons entitled to compensation.



**SEVERABILITY:** If any section, clause or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

**CONFLICTS:** This Ordinance repeals the provisions of any prior Ordinance in conflict herewith.

**EFFECTIVE DATE/CERTIFICATION:** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Toquerville City Council.
