RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TOQUERVILLE, UTAH, APPROVING AMENDED AGREEMENTS MODIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF: (1) AN AGREEMENT PREVIOUSLY ENTERED INTO ON JUNE 4, 1999 BY AND BETWEEN WASHINGTON COUNTY SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 1 AND ALLIED WASTE TRANSPORTATION, INC DBA RED ROCK WASTE SYSTEMS, AND (2) AN AGREEMENT PREVIOUSLY ENTERED INTO ON APRIL 8, 1999 BY AND BETWEEN SAID DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF TOQUERVILLE, UTAH.

WHEREAS District and Toquerville previously entered into an Agreement dated April 8, 1999, whereby District agreed to provide solid waste collection service to residences located within the boundaries of Toquerville in accordance with the terms of an Agreement between District and Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Red Rock Waste Systems, dated June 4, 1999; and

WHEREAS said Agreements provide for automated collection of waste placed in automated containers, as well as manual collection of waste placed in plastic bags, bundles or manual containers; and

WHEREAS District and Allied/Red Rock, believing that automated collection service is preferable to manual collection service in terms of enhancing operating efficiency and reducing the amount of litter caused by placement of waste in plastic bags or manual containers, have entered into an Agreement for Amendment of the June 4, 1999 agreement (hereafter referred to as Exhibit A), allowing municipalities the option of utilizing automated collection services only, thereby eliminating manual collection of waste in plastic bags, bundles and manual containers; and

WHEREAS District and Toquerville now desire to enter into an Agreement for the purposes of ratifying Exhibit A and approving an Amended Agreement modifying the April 8, 1999 agreement (hereafter referred to as Exhibit B) in order to allow Toquerville the opportunity to receive automated collection services only, thereby eliminating manual collection of plastic bags, bundles and manual containers; and

WHEREAS the City Council of Toquerville, Utah deems it necessary and expedient for the preservation of the public health,
