



Season begins March 1.

On Friday, March 1 the Toquerville Secondary Water System (TSWS) will be back on for the 2019 season.



Residential water schedule is from 6 p.m. to 2 a.m. on the following assigned watering day.

- Even numbered homes--Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
- Odd numbered homes--Monday, Wednesday, and Friday



Agriculture watering times are from 5 a.m. to noon. The days for each zone are the following:

- Zone 1: Tuesday and Friday
- Zone 2: Wednesday and Saturday
- Zone 3: Monday and Thursday

The zone areas remain the same, but if you're unsure of your zone, please send an email to julie@wcwcd.org and you'll receive a .pdf file designating the zones.



As of February 15, 2018, home vegetable gardens are allowed to be watered outside the residential watering time of 6 p.m. to 2 a.m., if following these criteria:

- The home vegetable garden must only be irrigated on the assigned watering day for that resident.
 - Even addresses--Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
 - Odd addresses--Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
- The home vegetable garden must be watered with a drip system.



Smart Meter Software

As many of you know, meters are being installed on all connections in TSWS. The information available from the meters improve management of the system and provide water use accountability, as well as support in using water more efficiently. This tool provides leak alerts and helps you manage your water needs based on local weather.



FREE Residential Water Checks

Beginning May 15, free water checks are offered to all residential homes in Washington County. A Water check includes meeting with a technician which runs a series of tests on your sprinkler system. The results provide system pressure, how evenly water is applied to the lawn area and how fast water is applied resulting in a recommended irrigation schedule. Water Waste Penalties

The following TSWS policy, which became effective on April 16, 2007, applies to all water users on the system.

After a water waste complaint has been received and verified, a warning notice will be sent for the first two verified violations. If a third violation is found valid, a fine of twice the annual assessed value for that parcel will be charged. A fourth valid water abuse complaint will result in a fine three times the assessed value. If this continues to a fifth water waste complaint, the water will be shut off (pertaining to lot/parcel in violation) for the rest of the season.

Violations include, but are not limited to:

- Watering outside of the watering times
- Water running off property
- Excess water forming on property creating temporary ponds.
