ELIGIBILITY

Davis Behavioral Health re-affirms its commitment to treatment services that are equitable and inclusive. In all aspects of its operations and at all levels of the organization, Davis Behavioral Health works to ensure that there is no discrimination on the basis of ethnicity, language, race, age, ability, sex, sexual or gender identity, sexual orientation, family status, immigrant or refugee status.

Mental Health Eligibility Criteria

Davis Behavioral Health determines eligibility of services based on severity of illness. Those with severe and/or persistent mental illness or a severe emotional disturbance (SPMI/SED) will be offered treatment services regardless of their ability to pay. Those with non-SPMI/SED conditions may be offered treatment services beginning with a screening to determine frequency and duration of services. Some non-SPMI/SED individuals may be referred to other community providers depending on DBH capacity.

Davis Behavioral Health, provides services to individuals and families enrolled in Medicaid and commercial insurances. DBH also provides services to individuals who are uninsured and underinsured.

Substance Use Disorder Eligibility Criteria

Substance use disorder eligibility is based on severity of treatment need within a context of limited capacity. Priority will be given to pregnant women, women with dependent children, intravenous drug users, and county residents. Contractual obligations are also honored. Federally mandated set asides and requirements of the State Division of Substance Abuse are followed.
