Step 6: As soon as someone grabs the spoon, everyone else should grab the spoon. Step 7: Whoever comes in empty will get a C with his name on the scorecard. Every time someone is left without a spoon, they get another letter in the word chicken. The first person to spell the whole word has to cling like a chicken - and that's the end of the game.
