See the explanations below for more details. Autumn colors fall, usually called fall outside North America, is one of four seasons that make up the year. It is the period of intervention between the warmest time of the year, summer and the coldest time of the year, winter. There are several ways to define the start and end dates of autumn. The two most used are based on the astronomical calendar and weather calendar. The astronomical and meteorological fall begins and ends on different dates. In the Astronomical the start and end dates of autumn are based on the Earth's changing position relative to the sun and solar events resulting from equinoxes and solstices. To the north north summer ends and autumn begins at the time of the September equinox, which occurs every year between 21 and 24 September. Autumn ends and winter begins at the time of the December solstice, which occurs every year between December 20 and December 23. In the southern hemisphere the hard fall from the March equinox (from 19 to 21 March) to the June solstice (from 20 to 22 June). The start and end dates of autumn given on this page are the astronomical drop dates in the northern hemisphere and are based on coordinated Universal Time (UTC), which for practical purposes is equivalent to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT - the UK time zone). While the fall begins and ends at the same time throughout the Northern Hemisphere, the date and local time differ from place to place depending on the year and time zone of a location. For locations that are ahead of UTC (further east) may fall the next day, and for places that are behind UTC (further west) may fall the day before. Meteorologists, on the other hand, define stations based on weather conditions and the annual temperature cycle. It is important that they can compare the same time period in different years. The duration of astronomical seasons varies between 89 and 93 days, while the duration of weather stations is less variable and is set at 90 days for winter in a non-jump year (91 days in a leap year), 92 days for spring and summer, and 91 days for autumn. While the exact definition of timing and duration of a season may differ in different areas depending on local conditions, in most of the northern hemisphere's weather drop is generally defined as the three months to September, October and November, with the season starting on September 1 and ending on November 30. There is no official rule that the drop definition to use, and different countries adhere to different conventions. Most of North America and Europe use astronomical fallout, while Australia and New Zealand use the weather drop (however, as these countries are in the southern hemisphere, the seasons are opposed and fall there hard from March to May). In other cultures, for example, in the traditional Chinese calendar and in Celtic traditions, the September equinox is considered roughly mid-autumn.
