Sim card toolkit unlocked phone

By Ashley Mackenzie When all your contacts and text messages are stored on your old mobile SIM card, you may not want to transfer everything to a new phone. Fortunately, the SIM card makes the process easy. The SIM card is designed to allow users to transfer information from the old phone to the new phone with minimal effort. As long as it fits in a new phone, you can use the old SIM card on your new phone, according to AT&T. To insert the old SIM card into the new phone, remove the battery from the phone, slide the SIM card into position and reinsert in the battery. If your new phone doesn't have a SIM card, you won't be able to use your old SIM card with it. You can transfer contacts and other information from your old SIM card to your new phone by putting the information on a USB drive - or having a professional at the phone store do it for you, according to CNET. By Nicholas Smith Unlocking your Sprint phone will allow you to use your device on another mobile provider's network. To use your phone with another provider, you must first unlock the phone and insert a new network SIM card. You can get unlock codes from Sprint for free. If you can't get a unlock code from your device from customer service, you'll need to get the code from an online provider for an additional fee. Get your phone's IMEI code, which is required to unlock the device. Press * #06 # on your device and the code will be displayed. Alternatively, get the code by removing the battery from the device, finding the printed digits inside the battery compartment. Call Sprint customer service at 888-211-4727. Request your unlock code from a customer service agent. Be prepared to give your phone model, IMEI code, and email to an agent. The agent will send the code to your email address. The email will include instructions for entering the code on your specific device. Purchase a unlock code from an online provider if you can't get the code from a Sprint customer service agent (see Resources). Be prepared to enter your model number, IMEI code, billing information, and email address. Check your email for unlock codes and instructions. Insert the non-Sprint SIM card into the device by removing the battery and the old SIM card. Slide the new card into the slot. Turn off the power on your phone by holding down the Power button. Enter the unlock code when you see the command, Enter Custom Code. Click Settings, Manage Connections and Turn Off All Connections.. Press the End Call button. Click Settings, Options, Advanced Options, and then select SIM card. Click Settings and Display Keyboard. Type the letter M E P D, then enter M E P 2. Enter your unlock code. The device prompts you when the phone is successfully unlocked Insert a new SIM card into the device and turn the device on. Click Manage Connections and select Play Play Connection's down. Click the Options button on the device screen. Click Advanced Options and SIM Card. Press the Menu button and select Show Keyboard. Enter M E P D, then enter M E P 2. Enter the unlock code when you see the Message Enter Network MEP Code. The phone will be unlocked. Turn off the device and insert the SIM card. Turn off the power on the phone. By Bruce Traxby Many people intelligently protect their SIM card with a PIN number, as this protects intruders from using your SIM card on their own phone; they can view through your contacts and effectively steal your mobile service and/or data. However, an example inevitably appears where you forgot your PIN number, or your SIM card was unresponsive. Fortunately for such cases, AT&T; T can give you an unlock PIN for your SIM card and allow you to use your phone with full functionality once again. Set up AN AT&T; ONLINE wireless account Q, or log in to your existing account. If you set it up for the first time, you'll need identification information, such as your phone number, address, and the last four digits of your Social Security number. Get the unlock code for your SIM card by selecting your device in the My Services section of your account. After clicking Unblock SIM card, the PUK code (Pin Unlock Key) will appear. Enter your PUK code in your phone's SIM settings. If you don't know where to find this, click the AT&T; Q: Phone/Device Support under Resources to find your user manual. Source: Jerry Hildenbrand / Android Central Just like a lock screen PIN code, a SIM PIN code is a way to make sure no one can use your SIM card without knowing the correct code. Every time a SIM card with a pin set is first placed on your phone, you'll need to know the PIN to unlock it for use. It's easy to set up a SIM card PIN, but you need to make sure you're ready in advance. Products used in this guide What is a SIM PIN? Very simply, a SIM PIN is a code, usually between four and six digits, that prevents the SIM card from being used if placed on a new phone, or even after rebooting the phone that is currently inserted into it. This is intended to ensure that stolen phones cannot be used to make phone calls, or to prevent unauthorized access to protected or secure phone numbers. SIM PIN codes are not very common anymore, but are often implemented in prepaid SIM cards that you purchase from stores or MVNO. Get ready If you set the SIM card PIN code for the first time you should be able to talk to the operator who issued the SIM card. You should get the so-called PUK code provided by the operator as well as instructions on entering it; Some have entered the PUK code through the phone dialer and some you have entered during the SIM card PIN code settings. It is best to have access to another work phone if you are locked and need to with the operator who issued your SIM card. Use mobile phone settings Go to settings on your phone and look for entries marked Security & Privacy. Near the bottom of the screen look for more settings or Advanced settings source: Jerry Hildenbrand / Android Central Select the sim card key marked with an entry and tap on it. On the next screen enter the slide button to enable locking of your SIM card. Enter your SIM card PIN code in the window that opens and saves your settings. Source: Jerry Hildenbrand / Android Central If you enter an invalid PIN code more than three times you will be locked out of service and need to talk to the operator who issued the SIM card. Remember, if you are doing this for the first time, you also need to talk to your operator. Do you really want or need a SIM card PIN key? What is a Sim Card? In short, SIM stands for Customer Identification Module. This is what connects the phone to a particular carrier and gives it a unique identifier such as a phone number. In simpler terms, this is a small card that allows your phone to get service from the carrier. There are several sizes of SIM cards available: Standard SIM, Micro SIM, and Nano SIM, each getting smaller than the previous one. As we mentioned before, there are three sizes. But there are also adapters available, although they are only one-way (converts smaller cards to fit a larger tray). So, if your phone is currently using Nano SIM, and your new phone is using Micro SIM, then you can pick up multiple adapters and use the same card without any problems. Note: Your carrier can provide a SIM adapter for free. How to Change Your SIM Card On an Android phone, you can usually find the SIM card slot in one of two places: under (or around) the battery or in a special tray along the side of the phone. How to Replace the SIM Found Under the Rear Plate If your phone has a removable rear plate or a user-replaceable battery, then chances are the SIM slot is somewhere under that back plate. For this phone, you first have to pull from behind and look for a small tray. Sometimes it will even be labeled—especially on phones with more than one SIM slot. In any case, it should look like this: There are several types of this particular slot. If your phone has a removable battery, you often have to pull the battery and simply slide the SIM card into the slot. At other times, the driver's license tray may have a little door on it. If so, slide the door towards the hinge, then lift it open. Drop the SIM card in place and then close the door. Note the notch that matches the SIM card in the lower corner of this particular phone. Regardless of the type of SIM tray your phone uses, you can open the back and fire the phone back (if you have to turn it off to remove the battery). How to Change SIM Around Phone Edges If your phone doesn't have a removable back, then you should check the outside edge of the phone to find the SIM tray. It is a small bay with a small hole on one side, as in the following figure. To remove it, you need the SIM removal tool. Most phones come with one in the box, and you can buy them at a very cheap price, but you can also use a small paperclip in a pinched state. To remove the SIM card tray, slide the removal tool into the hole and push. The tray may be easy to remove, or you may have to push with a little force. After all, it should appear without a ton of pressure. Once it appears a little, pull out the rest of the way. When you remove the tray, remove the old SIM (if any) and drop the new SIM in place—the tray is equalized to match the card (or vice versa), so you can't put it in the back. Just pop the tray back the way out (again, you can't put it in the back so don't worry), and you're ready to go. There's nothing to it! It
