Sometimes when I get advice, I do the opposite. That's just how I've been all my life. No one has ever been through exactly what you're going through, ever, the singer shared. Honestly, we can see Eilish's reasoning behind this election. Clearly, her personal ethos of advice has worked for the young star. Billie Eilish is a superstar. She's performed at Coachella.
