Modelling part 1In these images we see steps from intermediate model to sculptures ZBrush and retopology in retopology one subsection When I have an intermediate model, each part will be modeled separately using Extrude, Bevel, Connect Edge and Shell. Each element has its own center compared to its geometry, taking into account its topology and using progressive subsections. I create the original form using the least possible polygons, and then increase it. I use Editable Poly with turbosmooth modifier, and display the end result activated. ZBrush standard, Move, Smooth and ClayBuildup tools are used to drill down on robot clothes There are modeling methods that give less tension and a smaller number of polygons in the eye, but I usually use a high level of division for these illustrations. That's why I prefer the fastest method, although it may not be the simplest. I ZBrush only detail clothes using Standard, Move, Smooth and ClayBuildup tools. It is also very important to use masks. I use Topogun to retopologize the eye.04. Start UV mappingUVLayout was used for UV mapping, creating four maps of similar size and polygon number I always recommend using UVLayout UV mapping because it's an intuitive and stable program. In order to reduce costs, it is important to remember that the fewer cuts, the better. I always make them in areas that are less visible on camera. For this project, I created four maps of similar size and polygon graphs, grouping them in the most compact way, so that I could take full advantage of the entire UV space. For me, the way UV casings are displayed is not very important, because it will always generate id maps for different materials.05. All these materials use only three maps - Diffuse, Specular and Bump, because there are no comandant materials except the TV screen and ax metal. The various materials used are created with Fresnel IOR lighting information and Bump map information, but also using detailed digital data for reflection gloss and Fresnel reflections.09. Final lighting The final illustration lighting setup should provide insights about the symbol Final illustration lighting setup should provide insights about the symbol and create an atmosphere that dissolves the symbol with the environment. I want to create a confrontational atmosphere for my character. I use night light, a slightly illuminated HDRI and an improved electric light using VRayLights to highlight reflections and remove excessive contrast. I use two SpotLights to direct the light and get the right perception silhouette. In addition, the background was created with VrayLightsMaterial, using texture maps for building spotlights, windows and signs; and using SpotLights to illuminate the entire scene. VRayLights are used to highlight reflections and remove 10 for excessive contrast on stage. PostproductionIt is one of the most important steps of this kind of project. I unify the tone of the scene, emphasize the areas of light, correct the contrast, and lay blurred, in order to create a sense of depth to draw eyes into the fireplaces. All these steps are necessary to get a good result. Working in Photoshop, I set saturation, curves and levels to create a bokeh blur effect. Next I adjust render maps including Reflection, Specular and Alpha. The result is a complex image that shows character and conveys emotions and history.
