### **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-01**

## A RESOLUTION RATIFYING WATER RATES ADOPTED IN 2018

### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Twin Creeks Special Service District (the "District") is a special service district established by the County Legislative Body of Wasatch County, Utah, pursuant to the provisions of Utah law, for the purpose of providing culinary water, secondary irrigation water, and other services within the boundaries of the District;

WHEREAS, from time to time the District needs to update the fees charged to its customers to cover the cost of providing culinary and secondary irrigation water;

WHEREAS, in 2018, the District engaged Bowen Collins & Associates ("BC&A") to conduct a rate study to determine appropriate rates for culinary and secondary irrigation water;

WHEREAS, BC&A presented its findings at the District's public meeting held on November 11, 2018, and provided a final rate study dated November 29, 2018 (the "Rate Study");

WHEREAS, the District provided notice that it would consider the imposition of new or increased water fees at a public hearing to be held on December 11, 2018, in accordance with Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-643;

WHEREAS, the Wasatch County Council, acting as the governing board of the District (the "Board"), heard and considered public comment on the proposed fees at the December 11, 2018 public hearing;

WHEREAS, following the receipt of public comment at the December 11, 2018 public hearing, a motion to adopt the Rate Study was approved unanimously by the Board;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the new fees set forth in the Rate Study are necessary, and that adopting those fees are in the best interests of the District and its customers; and

WHEREAS, even though Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-643 does not require a formal resolution in order for a district to increase fees or impose new fees, the Board believes that as a matter of administrative clarity, it is desirable to ratify the Board's December 11, 2018 adoption of the Rate Study through this resolution, with a copy of the new rates attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, adopts this resolution:

- The Board hereby ratifies the December 11, 2018 adoption of the Rate Study, and the schedule of culinary water and secondary irrigation water fees set forth as Exhibit A.
- The Board ratifies and confirms that the rates set forth on Exhibit A are to be assessed as of January 1, 2019.
