I teach note, and I love the way that Seesaw allows my students and I to share what's going on in our classroom. My students are able to record their voices, take pictures of their work, and share their thoughts with me and their families via Seesaw. It's also a very quick way to communicate with parents. I use Seesaw to submit my weekly class newsletter and to send last minute announcements, too. Great way for teachers, parents and students to stay connected! Plus, it's a great place for teachers to share things with each other. I use so many assignments from the community of teachers in Seesaw to advance thinking and learning in my classroom. The only thing I would like to be different in Seesaw is that I would like to be able to assign things only to certain students rather than to the whole class. That would help me better differentiate my tasks. Maybe there's a way to do this and I haven't figured it out yet... 🙄 I'm not sure. But overall, Seesaw has been such a tool and a neat resource for my classroom! I've always loved Seesaw, but when we were suddenly thrown into distance learning I had to think about my feet and use Seesaw on a whole new level. Seesaw did not disappoint! I was able to use it to assign activities to students at different levels, on different days at different times. I could provide feedback and interact with my students through text or audio recordings. I could even record myself making changes to their assignments so they could see how to do their task. I also created a class blog so that my students could interact with each other while they were at home. This allowed them to post photos or videos and comment on each other's posts. I was still the moderator of all this. I was so delirious that my district now bought for all our primary schools to use! I highly recommend it!!!! Like many, I'm sure, I've been using the Seesaw app for distance learning during the Covid-19 pandemic. Overall, the app has been beneficial for teachers to share lesson plans and we use the app similar to a social media platform (FB) responding to teacher posts with assignments completed. Unfortunately, that's also why I only rate the app 3 stars. The point is that once I've responded to an activity posted by the teacher, there are no indicators that the particular assignment has been completed/answered by me, resulting in a lot of time spent searching through activities that need to be completed. I give up this problem to have read an email in Outlook and then come back later to that email, but all emails are marked as unread. It would be great if the developer created a means for were highlighted that they were answered/completed. In addition, it would be additionally useful if the application indicated that the reviewed the students' work and whether it needed to be redone. As an alternative to Google Classroom, use Seesaw as a more visual organizer for your resources. Seesaw has reconstructed classes created by other teachers. Seesaw is recommended for younger students. Is OUSD providing a paid version of Seesaw? Seesaw for Schools is the premium version of Seesaw and is being provided by the district for tk-2 and some Special Education classrooms. One of the features of this release is smart integration and escalation. Your Seesaw classes will be automatically listed with your students in Aeries, and students and teachers will be able to automatically log into Seesaw by clicking on a Seesaw icon - no username and password required. How do teachers and students at TK-2 start with this version of Seesaw? A new seesaw icon for TK-2 teachers and students is in Clever. This allows the signal connected with a single click. Teachers will see their classes cast (the lists sync with Aeries), and the students will see their classes. What if I'm not a TK-2/SPED teacher and I want to use seesaw?
13-12 classroom teachers can use the free Seesaw version or the paid Seesaw Plus version. See a comparison chart of the Seesaw plan. Your school can also purchase a Seesaw license for Schools. Only Seesaw for Schools offers full smart integration with single subscription and escalation.
Enrichment/preparation teachers can return to The Gangsaw for Schools for TK-2 students with some configuration (email helpdesk@ousd.org). Seesaw is a platform that you can use to host your class online. Seesaw uses a Learning Journal to collect students' work and assignments for the lesson. Students can show their work and thinking processes in real time by sending a video of themselves working through a mathematical problem, taking a picture of a paragraph that recording yourself by reading a poem or uploading a file to demonstrate your learning. Media or Google Classroom? Google's seesaw and classroom are amazing and free learning management systems that you can use to host your online class. The main differences between the two are: Seesaw and Google Classroom that allow you to assign work to students in your class. In Seesaw, these assignments are called activities, and can be assigned from an online work library created by other teachers, or created by you especially for your class. Once an activity is assigned, students can draw, create text, add a voice recording, photo, shapes, or caption to the assigned work. In the Google classroom, assignments take the form of Google Docs, Slides, Forms, or Sheets that students can edit and submit.
2. How families can interact with the ClassIn Classroom families can be individually invited by email address. Once invited by the teacher, families can choose summaries of the work assigned, completed and classified for their student. And you are a teacher OUSD TK-2, you have a Seesaw for Schools account, and no registration is required. Click the Seesaw icon on Clever, and your class should be there. For other teachers without a Seesaw for Schools account:

You can find specific serial-level guides coming here, which include set up checklists, student and teacher views, ideas for your classroom, and next steps. How do I add students to my Seesaw class? If you are an ousd TK-2 teacher, you have a Seesaw for Schools account, and no manual list is required. Seesaw for Schools syncs with Aeries to automatically list your students. Click the Seesaw icon on Clever, and your class should be there. For teachers without a Seesaw for Schools account:
Teachers choose whether students sign in to Seesaw with a student code or with their email/google account. Select the wrench icon --> class settings -- student login modes to change the student's login mode at any time. QR code sign class: Finish adding the names of your students by tapping + Students. Then print your QR Code class poster for students to use to log in. To find this Touch + Students (bottom right, below the lesson list) > tap Print the student sign on the poster. Student modes will choose I am a student in the Seesaw Class App, then the blue button scan code then scan the QR code of the class. Email / Google Sign In: Tap + Students (bottom right, below the class list). Share your Participation Code with your students. They'll type, create student accounts, and connect to your class from your devices using the Seesaw Class App.
Google Classroom Escalation: When you create your class, tap tap to select a class to import into Seesaw. If new students are added to Google Classroom, you can tap the wrench icon and then tap "Google Classroom import" to re-sync it in the class with Seesaw. Any new students in your Google classroom will be automatically added to your Seesaw class. No students will be removed from your Seesaw class when importing from Google Classroom.
We recommend using the Email/Google Sign In method unless you are directly importing students from Google Classroom. You can add up to 150 students to each Seesaw class. Check out more information about each login option in Seesaw's help content on this topic here. Can students and teachers log in through Clever? Yes, there is a seesaw icon for students, and a seesaw icon for teachers. Both are located in the Ousd Favorites section of the Clever portal. Teachers and students with a Seesaw for School account (including all TK-2 teachers) can log in by clicking the icon, and there is no addition login. For other teachers and students, when you click on one of these icons, you will go directly to the seesaw login screen. Just click Sign in to Google, and have you sign in. Can I add a co-teacher to my class? Teachers and co-teachers can approve, delete, or edit posts, invite and approve family members, edit class lists, etc. To add a co-teacher: Tap the profile icon and select the class you want to add a co-teacher to. Tap the wrench in the upper right corner and tap Manage teachers
Tap Invite teachers and enter the co-teacher's email address, tap send. Your co-teacher will receive an email with the invitation link. They must click the link to accept your invitation. They can create a new Seesaw account or sign in to an existing account. For more information, check out Seesaw's help content on this topic here. Which apps are supported by Seesaw? See a full list of supported apps here. Seesaw has 6 built-in creation tools: photo, drawing, video, upload, notes and link. Students can take a photo and annotate, caption and/or record audio in the photo. Students can use drawing tools and record their voice, add a caption or text to describe or tell a story about their drawing. Students can record videos and add captions to them. Students can upload an existing file from their device or Google Drive and annotate as needed using text, drawing, or voice. The notes tool allows a student to type and record their voice. Students can share any link using the link tool. They can also record their voice explaining which link or why they chose it. The they can change settings to allow students to see (not see) each other's work, to allow likes and comments, to require teacher approval on new items, and to enable editing of items. These settings are found by clicking the key icon in the upper right corner. How do I assign pre-created activities from Community Library? Seesaw has an extensive library of assignment activities created by other teachers. Start by clicking the green plus sign and selecting Add activity. Then click on the community tab, there you can search by grade, subject or keyword. Pre-created activities can be favorited and saved in your library by clicking on the heart. When you are ready to assign the pre-created activity, you can click the green assignment button. Free seesaw accounts can create up to 100 activities. How do I organize activities in my class using folders? Folders can help you organize your student's work by discipline or learning objective. You can create and manage folders by clicking the wrench icon in the upper right corner. Watch this video to learn more about setting up and using folders in Seesaw. The folders are visible to teachers, students and families in Seesaw. How do notes or feedback work in Seesaw? Teachers can give feedback using any of the 6 tools in Seesaw. Seesaw has two webinar recordings in their help content that go deep into the feedback of students in Seesaw, one for PreK-2 and one for All Series. Both are just over 30 minutes long. Students can give point-to-point feedback using the same tools. Check out this sample assignment on peer feedback from the Seesaw Activity Library. Families can connect to Seesaw using the internet in app.seesaw.me or by downloading the Seesaw Family App (iOS or Android). Students must be added to the lesson before families are invited. Families can be invited by email, text message or QR codes. Families only have access to their son's journal. They can see the student's work marked with their child's name and post the teacher's labels with Everyone. Families will also be able to see comments made by any user on their children's posts. Family members cannot see the content of any other Can I use Seesaw to contact students and families? You can post ads for Seesaw and select if you want them to go to students, families or both. How can students or families access Seesaw on a phone or tablet? Families use a different app to access Seesaw than students. Families use the Seesaw Family App or or on a computer. Students use the Seesaw or Seesaw.me class application on a computer.
