We've done the course in Chocorua and we're trying to give that experience, said Nathan Walker, from New London, who took on his daughter Megan and son-in-law Mick Nagle, who visited from the Sunshine Coast to Australia with their children Ronan and Lachlan. By the first hour in the latest Monkey Trunks had passed there were over forty adventurers climbing, swinging and zip among a fabulous structure. Among the first arrivals were Karen Familia from Northfield, whose youngest Cassie was the winner of the grand prize at the Design Course competition. Smart relays or monkey paws are designed so that both cannot be disconnected from the safety lines at the same time. A member of the Monkey Trunks safety team passes over the proper use of equipment before starting. Cassie, nine, had read about the race in a local newspaper. Just four days into the race, Cassie went to work, creating a series of designs and one of them was chosen. It is called Cassie's Lomurs resemble a series of mushroom-looking wooden platforms, which each adventurer must carefully guide through it. I don't know where I got the idea from, Cassie said. The courses are suitable for anyone over 3 years old, with two King Kong Courses, one for those under four feet tall and one for those taller than four feet, All courses have a maximum weight limit of 2501bs. Dropzone also has a minimum weight limit of 44lbs. The Monkey Trunks safety team will give you a full briefing on how to properly use your belt and how to manoeuvre the course, including introductory video and what to do if you get into jam. Most beginners will start from the Discovery Course as it helps you gain a little confidence for a higher-level course. In all courses, you are always attached to the safety line and you can not fall. In fact, Monkey Trunks uses Belays, which allows participants in the Discovery course to make transfers and choose their own route to ensure that they cannot be accidentally removed from the system. Monkey trunks high ropes and Zili Park has three levels with over 40 challenges. There is also The Expoglide at the lower level of the course, a permanent safety system. They come at the end of the course, so you need to complete at least a few of the many challenges to use them, but it's all part of the great fun. A young adventurer accidentally walks through the balance. Megan and Lachlan Gle move away from Lily pads. The course is designed to hold up to 100 adventurers at a time, but Monkey Trunks staff keep it up to a maximum of 80, so time through the course moves at a pleasant pace. Monkey trunks high rope and Zilin Park was created to allow an adventurer to achieve the course on his own, but there is always a member of the safety team nearby to make sure everything stays safe. All rescue teams receive 5 days of training at the beginning of each season and all are CPR certified. Still, they seem to be having as much fun as adventurers. The Monkey Trunks Safety Squad is always available for help. Cassie Karen from Northfield with her father Glenn. Cassie won the grand prize for designing the course for Cassie's Leiuri for the new Monkey Trunks. You couldn't ask for a better job in the summer, said Brendan, one of the safety drivers. Some of the things they heard from adventurers, climbing and rocking above on opening day: I just had an interesting tyre adventure. I'm glad you convinced me. Can we do this again before we leave? Monkey Trunks in Funspot proved that this is an attraction that is gaining appeal. More Monkey trunks are planned for other areas up and down the northeast.
