The film's success led to the release of two licensed video games, a 4D movie amusement park attraction, two spin-off films called The Lego Batman Movie and The Lego Ninjago Movie, which were released in 2017, Unikitty! The animated television series, which also came out the same year, and the sequel to the original film titled Lego Movie 2: Part Two in 2019. Plans for a third spin-off movie later shelved. The franchise has received an overall positive critical reception, with the exception of The Lego Ninjago Movie, which received mixed reviews and has grossed \$1 billion at the global box office. Pictures and Village Roadshow Pictures almost unanimous recognition; Critics praised his visual style, humor, voice cast and heartwarming message. It earned more than \$257 million in the U.S. and Canada and \$210 million in other territories, for a worldwide total of more than \$469 million. The film won the BAFTA Award for best animated film, the Critics' Choice Film Award for best animated feature and the Saturn Award for best animated film. Lego Batman Movie (2017) Main article: Lego Batman movie october 2014, Warner Bros. [1] [2] Will Arnett returned to the voice of Batman, with Chris McKay, who had previously added a sequel to directing the film, a story written by Seth Grahame-Smith, and a movie by Dan Lin, Roy Lee, Phil Lord and Christopher Miller. [3] On April 20, 2015, Warner Bros. scheduled the Lego Batman movie on February 10, 2017. [4] In July 2015, Michael Cera, co-star of development arrested by Arnett, was cast to Robin. [5] In August 2015, Zach Galifianakis concluded negotiations on calling the Joker. [6] In October 2015, Rosario Dawson was cast to Barbara Gordon, the daughter of Police Commissioner James Gordon, who later became the heroine of the heroine Batgirl. [7] The following month Ralph Flynn was cast as Alfred Pennyworth,[8] Bruce Wayne's butler. Mariah Carey, although initial reports indicated that she was playing Commissioner Gordon,[9] was actually cast as Mayor McKaskills. [10] The first trailer for the film was released on March 24, 2016, followed by the second on March 28, 2016. The film was released in the United States on February 10, 2017. The score was made up of Lorne Balfe. [11] Lego Ninjago movie (2017) Main article: Lego Ninjago Movie Brothers Dan and Kevin Hageman, who wrote Ninjago: The Masters of Spinjitzu and co-wrote the story of The Lego Movie, co-wrote an adaptation of the Lego Ninjago films, which features a new feature different from the TV series. Charlie Bean, who produced Disney's Tron: Rebellion, directed the film, produced by the Lego Movie team of Dan Lin, Roy Lee, Phil Lord and Christopher Miller. [31] A cut-off film was released on September 23, 2016. [32] On April 20, 2015, the film was postponed until September 22, 2017, when Stork took over the film's original release date. [12] In June 2016 the cast was announced to include Jackie Chan, Dave Franco, Michael Peña, Abbi Jacobson, Kumail Nanjiani, Zach Woods and Fred Armisen respectively. On February 3, 2014, Jared Stern and Michelle Morgan were asked to write the screenplay. [12] On February 21, 2014, the studio planned for the release of May 26, 2017. [13] On March 12, 2014, Deadline reported that co-director Chris McKay would lead the sequel from Phil Lord and Christopher Miller as producers. [14] Warner Bros. did not invite co-ists to the first film Village Roadshow come back as a participant in the sequel because Of Warner Bros., which now has more confidence in the film and is trying to keep as much profit as possible for itself. [15] On 10 April 2014, McKay said he wanted to introduce more women to results than men. [16] On 28 July 2014, chris pratt was reported to be interested in a vengeance of the role of emetics. [required quote] In October 2014, Warner Bros. scheduled the Lego Batman movie for 2017 and Lego Movie 2 in 2018. [1] By October 25, 2014, Lord and Miller had signed up to write Lego Movie 2[18] Writers have implied that the result will take place four years after the Lego Movie events. [19] In February 2015, Warner Bros. announced that the title of the sequel had been changed to a Lego Movie Sequel and that Rob Schrab, a Monster House co-writer, replaced McKay as director as McKay went on to devior from the Lego Batman movie. [20] According to an interview at the Santa Barbara International Film Festival, the sequel will focus on Emmet and his sister, who are going on a strange, dystopian version of Bricksburg. [21] On April 20, 2015, Warner Bros. scheduled the Lego Movie Sequel for the May 18, 2018 release. [4] On June 17, 2016, the film was delayed until February 8, 2019. [22] Until July 2016, Raphael Bob-Waksberg was hired to rewrite this script. [23] By February 2017, Srab was replaced by Mike Mitchell, reportedly due to creative differences. [24] On September 6, 2017, it was announced that the production of the Lego Movie Sequel will begin in Canada on October 2, 2017. [25] [26] It was also announced that the Lord and Miller have returned to rewrite the script to deal with gender issues about how the girl plays against how the boy plays. [27] On March 23, 2018, it was confirmed that Tiffany Haddish was thrown into the film as a new lead character, but returning actors would be Pratt as regular guy turned Master Builder Emmet Brickowski, Elizabeth Banks as Wyldstyle, Arnett as Batman, Channing Tatum as Superman and Jonah Hill as Green Lantern. [28] On May 21, 2018, Warner Bros. officially renamed The Movie Lego Movie 2: Part Two, along with the release of the first teaser poster. [29] [30] This is the last Lego Movie movie to be released by Warner Bros. Canceled the film Billion Brick Race in March 2015, Warner Bros. announced that a third Lego Movie spin-off, titled Billion Brick Race, was in development. By July 2016, Jason Segel and Drew Pearce signed the project as co-directors and co-authors. [31] [32] [33] In August 2017, it was announced that Jorge R. Gutierrez had been recruited to replace Pearce as At that time, the film was scheduled to be released on May 24, 2019. [34] By February 2018 Gutierrez had left the project. [35] In July 2018, Pearce announced that the film's story is a Lego racing movie inspired by previous racing films, including Cannonball Run. [36] In December 2019, the film's main article concept art was revealed to the film's original director Jorge R. Gutierrez, together with confirmation that the project had been cancelled. The poor box office results of the previous two Lego films along with the film's long conceptual phase were given as the main reason. [37] [38] Possible Future Untitled The Lego Batman Movie sequel in December 2018 Chris McKay confirmed that the result is under development and that he will return to lead the film. [39] However, the fate of this film is now unlikely as Warner Bros. will lose Lego movie rights with Universal to set the deal as future Lego movie distributors, while dc Comics rights are owned by Warner Bros. [quote required] In the Future Universal Pictures era in December 2019, Universal Pictures entered into early talks to distribute upcoming movie properties based on Lego toys. While the original Lego Movie characters and movies are still owned by Warner Bros. Pictures, Universal Pictures will develop and distribute future Lego movies. In April 2020, an agreement with Universal was set to limit the 5-year film deal with Warner Bros. still owned by previous films. [40] Television Unikitty! (2017-2020) Main article: Unikitty! In May 2017, Warner Bros. and Lego announced that Unikitty, a character from Lego Films, will receive a spin-off of animated television series cartoons on the network. On the show, she is emptied by Tara Strong. The premiere date was January 1, 2018, and the show's executive producers are Phil Miller, Christopher Miller, Dan Lynn, Roy Lee, Jill Wilfert and Sam. Ed Skudder (creator of Dick Figures and co-creator of Dogsnack) and Lynn Wang (co-creator of dogsnack) are signed as producers, while Aaron Horvath serves as a monitoring producer. [41] [42] [43] The series on October 27, 2017 showed a special/look-in peek called Spooooky Game. [44] The series on November 17, 2017 showed a second sneak peek of Sparks And the third and final pour into the peer/Christmas suddses on December 1, 2017. On August 27, 2020, the series ended with a two-share finale titled Birthday to The End of All Birthdays. Short films for short films set in the franchise were produced. It was created by then 6-year-old Markus Jolly. Michelangelo and Lincoln: History Cops (2014) Michelangelo and Lincoln: History Cops is a stop-motion animated short film included in the Lego Movie website media release. It is presented as a trailer for a fictional action blockbuster starring master builders, Michaelangelo and Abraham Lincoln as they fight crime. Enter Ninjago (2014) Enter Ninjago is a short film included in the home media release Lego Movie[45]. The Hollywood president sits down with Emmet and changes up the plot of the Lego Movie to prominently feature ninjas for marketing purposes. They eventually decide to create a new ninja-based film called Super-Crunchy Ninja Skateboard Party movie with pratfalls to slash physical comedy and cute furry animals for international audiences, which in short jokingly states became the largest box office ball in the history of cinema. The whole movie is a reference to Lego Ninjago. Master (2016) Master is a 2016 computer animated short film written and directed by Jon Saunders, co-directed by Ross Evans, Carey Yost and Remington D. Donovan and produced by RyanPrin Hal. The short film was released on September 23, 2016 with Warner Animation Group's storks, as well as the early shows of the Lego Batman film in the UK. It stars Jackie Chan as Master Wu, Abbi Jacobson as Chicken, and Justin Theroux as the announcer. [46] Short follows Wu and annoying chicken. This is the first Lego short film to be released in theaters, and is also the first theatrical short film from the Lego Movie franchise. Dark Hoser (2017) Dark Hoser is a short film included in the home media release of the Lego Batman movie[47]. Batman attends an attempt to apply to be a member of the Justice League of America, but only learns he could be Canadian. Batman is simply not that into you (2017) Batman is just not that into you in a short film included in the home media release of The Lego Batman Movie [48]. Harley Quinn hosts a talk show and helps the Joker break up with Batman. Cooking with Alfred (2017) Cooking with Alfred is a short film included in the Lego Batman Films website release[49]. Alfred hosts a cooking show with Batman and Robin as his guest stars. Movie Sound Effects: How do they do it? (2017) Movie sound effects: how to do it? is a short film included in the Lego Batman Movie home media release[50]. Bane, Riddler, Poison Ivy and Catwoman are brought into the sound booth to help record the sound effects of the Lego Batman Movie. Shark E. Shark in Which way ocean? (2017) Shark E. Shark in Which Direction to The Ocean? is a short film included in the home media release of the Lego Ninjago movie[51].
