You need to consider wind direction and speed in relation to your ship as shown in the three arrows around your ship. If you try to go upwind, you will have a hard time moving. A red cone will mean that it is not possible to move forward in a certain direction if you try to go in the opposite direction of the wind. The only way around it is to move the wind in order to gain momentum then quickly maneuver towards the opposite direction. You will need to do this repeatedly until you get to where you want to go, so it will take time. Be sure to speed up game time to make the whole process a little more bearable. 2. Raise the right flag One trick that you can do to keep enemy ships from attacking you until you get within reach is to use the same flag as them. This will trick them into thinking you are from the same country, allowing you to access it safely. Once you are within range, you can launch a surprise attack, making it easier for you to overwhelm enemy ships. Keep in mind, however, that after using this tactic, you will be labeled as a pirate and future enemies will be able to see through your trick. It will take a while before you can try that trick again. 3. Try Economy Games Another great feature of this game is how dynamic the market is. You can be a professional trader by buying items where they are cheap then travel to another city that will buy the goods at a higher price. Of course, you need to find out where to go on what before you can start trading. When you're in town, drop by your local pub and buy everyone a round of drinks. This will make them chatty and give you advice on where to buy and sell. Remember that you can also use items that you buy for your own ship. If you have all the right captains, you can use any commodity to improve performance. For example, you can use rum to improve your ship's speed by 10%. 4. Master sailing! You will see a line of three arrows pointing in the direction around your ship. This indicates the current direction and wind speed flowing, and you will need to maneuver your ship accordingly. If you point the ship in exactly the opposite direction, you will see a red cone forming. This is a motionless zone, and if your ship is turned to the middle, you will hear one of your coworkers that you are in the irons – that is, you have zero forward movement. To get around this you have to build up speed from the wind, then rocking back and forth in the opposite direction. Be sure to speed up game time if you want this process to go a little faster. It can be difficult sailing wind, but it's possible! Use flags to get a jump on enemies! The tutorial will teach you how to trick enemy ships into thinking you are from a particular country. It allows you to get the first punch on them because they won't be hostile to you when you're nearby. It is important to remember that you can only do this once before you are marked as a pirate, allowing other enemies to see through your disguises. To remedy this you can change the name of your ship, but it's quite costly to do so. Make your surprise attack count as you don't get any more for some time. Play market! Guests can stop by the local tavern when visiting the city. If you buy a round of beer for the people inside, you may hear some gossip and rumors that usually represent the current price of the items. You may hear that a certain item is super cheap somewhere or expensive. Check the city shop and check out all the prices that are highlighted in green – that is, it is sold cheaper than usual. In addition to buying a lot of goods and using it for yourself, you can also travel on over to a city where the item in question is expensive and sell it back for a profit. Buy low, sell high! Each of the commodity items has the use of battle. Rum, for example, temporarily increases the speed of your ship by 10%. Keep in mind, however, that you will need a specific master equipped before you can use an item like this. Stay on the move during the fight! The quickest way to end up in Davy Jones' locker is to stay a sitting duck during the battle. Don't just sit back and let the enemy take free shots at you – stay moving! Turn the camera so that you can keep the enemy in plain sight and use the appropriate weapons. Try to align your target with your targeting cone so that they meet at the very end of the cone. If your target is too close to your ship, your shots will end up flying directly over them. Don't forget your captain's special abilities, too. Some captains have active skills that can be used from the submenu above the sailing button. If you see (A) next to the option, it means that it must be manually activated, while (P) indicates a passive capability that is always active. For example, Edward Teach explosive powder barrels is an active capability that allows your ship to drop an explosive barrel trap behind it. Great for getting ships off the tail!
