## Baltimore city warrant check

Search warrants don't just come out of nowhere. The judge issues an arrest warrant (a form authorizing the police to arrest you and present you in court) for probable cause. The probable cause means that the law enforcement agency believes that he or she has sufficient information about the crime to make a lawful arrest [sources: Business Dictionary, FindLaw]. But you don't have to commit a felony or violent crime to attract such attention from the court. You may have an active warrant for many reasons, including something as simple as unpaid speeding tickets or a late trial date. Under the circumstances, you may have no idea that an arrest warrant has been issued against you. Here are some ways to find out if you have a valid warrant [sources: free counseling, Hernandez]: Find the Local Records website for your district court or sheriff's department. In populous counties, these sites are regularly updated with accurate information. In small counties and areas with too few staff in sheriff's offices, such online resources may not exist, or they may not be accurate. Similarly, some kind of information (such as domestic violence cases) is unlikely to be public. If you believe the federal warrant is in effect, you must bless the federal court in your district. Call the local bail bond. He may have access to a county database that contains active warrants. Hire a lawyer. Lawyers have access to databases that are not accessible to the public. It costs money to hire a lawyer, of course, but you get the information you're looking for. You can also check warrants on public records search sites, such as Governmentregistry.org. These for-profit third-party websites ping different record databases, including warrants. Keep in the way that these types of sites don't offer their data for free. They can issue a warrant as long as you give a full name and date of birth. Another option would be to get a friend to call for you. Just 35 miles apart are Baltimore and Washington Chesapeake Bay, at the mouth of major rivers. You can drive between the two in about an hour if the traffic jams aren't too bad. There are many reasons why the inhabitants of each city love where they live. But which of these cities is in better shape at the moment? And how do they stack up against each other in terms of income and cost of living? Keep reading so you can quickly view the numbers of these two Mid-Atlantic gems. Washington is bigger and richer than Baltimore Washington is a larger city, with an estimated 702,756 people calling it home, while Baltimore is home to 601,188 people. It's only for cities. In the surrounding metro areas, where you'll find the state's most expensive zip code, there's an even bigger difference: the Washington-Arlington-Alexandria area has more than 6 million residents, while the Baltimore-Columbia-Towson metro area has 2.8 million people. And that abyss isn't. As of the 2010 census, Baltimore was actually a larger city with 620,961 residents for Washington's 601,723 residents. Over the past eight years, however, it is estimated that Washington's population growth has been 16.8%, while Baltimore actually shrank by 3.2%, making it one of five cities among the country's 100 largest cities with declining populations during that period. Economically, Washington citizens tend to be in much better shape, with a median household income of \$72,935 — more than 30 percent more than the national figure of \$55,322 — and a poverty rate of 17.9 percent. Baltimore's median household income is only \$44,262 and the poverty rate is 23.1 percent. Similarly, unemployment is a much bigger issue for Baltimore, with an unemployment rate of 4.6%, compared with just 3.6% in Washington. Watch: Rental costs vs. home ownership in every state, but Washington is also much more expensive Baltimore residents can take comfort in the fact that their paychecks extend much further in Maryland than in the nation's capital. Washington's total cost of living is on average 59% higher than in the country as a whole. Baltimore is 10% cheaper. That's partly why it takes only \$72,194 to live comfortably in Baltimore, but \$90,811 in Washington. Cost of living in city vs. suburbs across America, while cost of cost Transportation, health care and grocery aren't that different between the two, Washington's housing costs are very high - more than two and a half times the national average. Baltimore residents pay more than a third less than the rest of the country to secure housing. The situation is consistent regardless of whether you are renting or buying. Baltimore's median rent is \$1,298 a month, just about half the \$2,583 a month you need to rent a median-priced apartment in Washington. This makes Baltimore one of the best cities in the country for tenants, found a previous GOBankingRates study. If you want to buy a home, that's an even clearer difference. Baltimore's median home value of \$125,500 is less than a quarter of the median value of a Washington home of a whopping \$553,600. This makes Washington one of the U.S. cities where more than half of households can't afford a home. Baltimore wins in other areas, also, of course, the city figure has much more to do than with facts and figures, and both Washington and Baltimore have more to offer. In addition to sharing geography, both cities are full of U.S. history. Many of the country's most prominent landmarks and museums call the country's capital home. Baltimore is the birthplace of Edgar Allen Poe and Babe Ruth, where Francis Scott Key wrote the Star Spangled Banner while watching the bombing of nearby Fort McHenry. Baltimore can also demand a better city mantle for retirees who want to spend less.
