Mayor Brown called for any addenda to the agenda and there were none.

CONSENT AGENDA

Items: A. & B. Approval of the Bills, Payroll, Minutes

Councilman Heward made a motion to approve the bills, payroll, and minutes of the October 10th, 2023 regular council meeting. Councilman Thompson seconded and the motion carried.

Item: A. Presentation of Operation Facelift Award

Mary Hollenbeck presented the City with an award for Outstanding Community Facelift, for the summer Operation Facelift Projects that took place.

Item: B. Discussion & Possible Approval of the Beer & Wine License Application from Magic Valley Food Services LLC

City Clerk, Bayley Maughan, presented the Mayor and Council with an application for a beer and wine license for Magic Valley Food Services LLC, DBA E Street Deli. The application was complete and there were no concerns.

Item: D. Discussion & Possible approval of the Easement for the Carney Building Sewer Line

In order to connect to city services, the most logical location of the line would have to be partially on the City's property at the back of the buildings.

There was not a legal description available yet for an easement to be drafted and approved. Anthon was asking for the authorization to draft an easement and allow the Mayor to sign the same and allow for the line to be placed.

Councilman Heward made a motion to authorize the City Administrator and Attorney to draft an easement for the placement of a sewer line behind the City bathroom building and allow the Mayor to sign the same. Councilman Heward seconded and the roll call was as follows:
