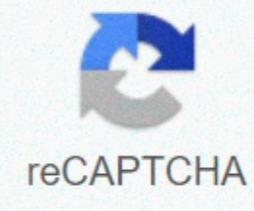

World championship lol 2019 teams

The 2019 League of Legends world will soon be open. The event will feature the best teams in the world fighting for a shot at winning the Summoner's Cup. And for the first time, there's hope in LEC that the home team can get to the finals and become world champion. But first, teams must actually qualify for a shot to make a run at the worlds. Different teams from several leagues around the world have to develop to have the opportunity to represent their region, but few can actually do it. As in previous years, the top two teams from LCS, LCS, and LMS will be placed in the group stage, but there's been a change of guard this year. After winning The Invictus Gaming 2018 Worlds, only two LCK teams will go directly to the group stage, while all three LPL teams will be flown into the pool together with the vcs first seed. This means that the third seed from LCS, LEC, LCK, and LMS, and the second seed from VCS will be forced to fight in the play-in stage against the International Wildcard Team shot at the final four spots in the group stage. Here are all the teams attending the Worlds as well as how they qualified for this event. LCS (North America) Team Liquid: First seed after beating Cloud9 in the LCS Finals 3-2 on Aug 25. Cloud9: Second seed since taking the most championship points in LCS. Clutch Gaming: Third seed after defeating TSM in the LCS regional qualifier on Sept. 8. LEC (Europe) G2 Esports: First seed after defeating Fnatic in the LEC Summer Finals. Fnatic: Second seed after taking down Splyce in the regional qualifier finals. Splyce: Third seed after falling to Fnatic in regional qualifier finals. LCK (South Korea) SK Telecom T1: First seed after defeating Griffin in the LCK Summer Finals. Griffin: The second seed because of its most championship points at LCK. DAMWON Gaming: Third seed after winning the 2019 LCK Regional Finals. LMS (TW/HK/MCO) J Team: First seed after winning the 2019 LMS summer crown. Ahq Esports Club: Second seed since having the most championship points in the region. Hong Kong attitude: third seed after winning the 2019 LMS regional final. LPL (China) FunPlus Phoenix: First seed after beating RNG at the 2019 LPL Summer Championships. Royal Never Give Up: Second seed since having the most championship points in the LPL. Invictus Gaming: Third seed in the LPL after beating Top Esports in the LPL Regional Finals. VCS (Vietnam) GAM Esports: First seed after taking down Team Flash in VCS Summer Finals. Lowkey Esports: Second seed as VCS Summer runners-up. CBLOL (Brazil) Flamengo Esports: Won the CBLOL 2019 Split 2 Final. LCL (Russia) Unicorns of Love: Defeated Vega Squadron in the LCL Summer Finals September 15. LJL (Japan) Detonation FocusMe: Qualified through the LJL 2019 Summer Finals. LLA (Latin America) Isurus Defeated all knights in the final games of 2019. It took place from 2 October 2019 to 10 November 2019 in Berlin, Madrid and Paris. [1] Twenty-four teams from 13 regions qualified for the tournament based on their placement in regional circuits such as China, Europe, North America, South Korea and Taiwan/Hong Kong/Macao, and twelve of these teams have to reach the main event through the playing phase. Qualified teams and magazines Qualified teams based on mid-season invitational and World Championship results of the previous year, with the 2018 MSI victory at Royal Never Give Up and the 2018 Worlds Invictus Gaming victory, the third seed team from China (LPL) will start the group stage, replacing the third seed team from South Korea (LCK), which will now start the game.
