Overview The Tennessee Department of Human Services licenses adult daycare and enacts rules that set the standards for adult daycare. State Medicaid HCBS does not cover adult day care services under waivers or has a 1,115 Demonstration Medicaid Waiver for a PACE program that covers adult day care but under the state plan. Licensure and Certification Requirements Defines An adult day care center is a facility that provides adult day care services. Adult day care services are services provided by the provider of such non-adult-related services to ten or more adult recipients for more than 3 hours a day but less than 24 hours a day, in accordance with a personalized care plan designed to maintain or restore each adult's most appropriate capacity for self-care through medical or social services. Who Can Serve Parameters for individuals who need a structured organized activity program that provides personal care, personal development, personal development and development are suitable for adult nursery services. Individuals who present a significant threat to themselves or others, or who prevent intellectual, emotional or behavioral level from benefiting from a center's care plan, are not eligible for adult nursery services. The Department is entitled to audit at all times and may review any licensed or suspicious adult nursery at any time upon appropriate identification, without prior notification or in any way with the aim of fulfilling its licensing responsibilities. The direct staff ratio will consist of at least one direct care staff for every eight participants. Direct care personnel are individuals whose regular work responsibilities are in face-to-face contact with participants. Volunteers can be considered to determine direct care staff-participant ratios, provided that the training and training of volunteers meets the minimum requirements of the filled personnel positions. Volunteers who do not meet these minimum requirements may not be counted at the required rate, but they can help staff and other qualified volunteers. However, responsible paid direct care staff should always be present if volunteers are used. Volunteers who do not meet the minimum qualifications should always be supervised directly by care staff. For on-site events involving all participants, such as watching movies, watching special presentations, or observing performances, it may not be necessary to have a ratio of eight staff-participants, and a smaller number of staff can be used. However, no fewer than two direct care staff can be available when there are nine or more participants. Off-site activities, such as field trips, may need to use the number of staff exceeding the one to eight staff ratio required to provide adequate supervision to participants due to their physical or mental state. Training Requirements Orientation and continuous training/training will be provided to the staff to fulfill their duties. Staff development training will be provided regularly to all employees for at least 8 hours a year. This training may include counselling, workshops or conferences, as well as in-service training provided by the agency. The training should include training perch as well as reporting an adult's abuse, neglect or exploitation to the Department to ensure staff recognise signs and symptoms of an adult's abuse, neglect or exploitation. All staff responsible for transporting adults will be adequately trained in transport rules every 6 months. Related Medicaid Contract Requirements for Adult Day Services Providers The state has a 1115 Demonstration Medicaid Waiver for a PACE program that includes adult day care. PACE is a single program run by an organization of the Catholic Church. There is a mini health clinic within the agency and it must be licensed. On Tuesday, Tom Pelissero reported that the NFL Network Tennessee Titans had three new players, and five new staff members tested positive for COVID-19. The Titans and Vikings, who welcome Tennessee on Sunday, have suspended their teams. ESPN's Dianna Russini, a league source, told him we're closing Tennessee until Saturday, meaning Titans players and coaches won't practice this week. The outbreak presents the NFL with the first real test of the epidemic season, and for the first time, the potential titans put the league at risk of losing a game, as scheduled to play the Steelers on Sunday. Without a week of training to prepare, the Titans will be at serious disadvantage if Sunday's game goes ahead as planned. And if the league chooses to cancel or postpone the game, the NFL has to find out how to compensate the teams concerned. In a statement, the Titans shed light on the details, stating that the team is working to confirm positive tests and will have more information on Wednesday. With the exception of the abundance of attention, the organization decided to work remotely today as following NFL protocols on the covid-19 virus, the statement said. Several tests have been positive and they are working on the verification process. We'll know more tomorrow. The chances of getting COVID-19 for a full season without being in a single state were not in favor of the NFL, but the league had been hoping that through regular testing, contact monitoring and other proactive measures, it would be possible to contain outbreaks if teams occurred.
