E. S. Edwards, who was considered a leading expert on pyramids. Biography Born in London, he was the son of Edward Edwards (1870-1944) of the British Museum, and his wife Ellen Jane Higgs. He attended merchant Taylor School, where he studied Hebrew, and then at Gonville and Kaius College in Cambridge, receiving first class in Oriental languages. He was awarded William Wright students in Arabic and received his doctorate in 1933. In 1934, Edwards joined the British Museum as an assistant custodian in the Department of Egyptian and Assyrian Antiquities. In 1939, he published hieroglyphic texts for Egyptian steles. During World War II, he was sent to Egypt for military service. In 1946, he wrote The Pyramids of Egypt, which was published by Penguin Books in 1947. In 1955 he was appointed Keeper of Egyptian Antiquities at the British Museum and organized the Tutankhamun exhibition in 1972. He remained there until his retirement in 1974. Leaving the British Museum, he worked with UNESCO during the rescue of the temple complex in Philae. He was also Vice-President of the Egyptian Intelligence Society, a member of the British Academy (1962) and was appointed CBE in 1968 for his services at the British Museum. The Edwards family married Elizabeth Lisle in 1938. They had a daughter and a son.
